



## Hardship/Scholarship Application Form Competitive Soccer

The Florida Premier FC (FPFC) Hardship/Scholarship program provides assistance to our families who are experiencing financial hardships. The Hardship/Scholarship committee will consider all completed applications received by July 1, 2018. (However, there is a limited amount of Scholarship/Hardship money so it will be awarded on a first come basis). The amount of scholarship awarded (if any) may be up to 50% of Registration/Club fees (not to include team fees) depending on the number of applicants and amount of hardship/scholarship funds available. FPFC is a non-profit organization with a limited amount of hardship/scholarship funding. No guarantee of assistance is implied in this application.

Florida Premier FC enables members to pay Club registration fees over a six-eight (6-8) month time frame by making monthly allotments. If you are in a hardship situation and need these payments extended over a few more months, please make this request through the treasurer at [jgendebien@verizon.net](mailto:jgendebien@verizon.net).

If you are approved for a hardship/scholarship—the amount approved will be applied to your registration/club fees after your required payment amount is met. (For example: if you are approved for 50% hardship monies from the Club—these monies will be applied after you have met your 50% obligation.) Failure to meet this obligation may result in your child being placed in bad standing with the Florida Youth Soccer Association (FYSA) and as a result, unable to participate in Season (CDL/USA) games or tournaments.

### Hardship/Scholarship requirements for eligibility:

- Commitment to Florida Premier FC and to attend scheduled practices and games of assigned team
- Participation by family member/player for 1 hour of volunteer time for every \$10 sponsored during the season. (Exact required volunteer hours will be assigned by the Hardship/Scholarship committee upon approval of scholarship monies). Volunteer work will be under the direction of the Hardship/Scholarship Committee and may consist of field maintenance, field marshalling, parking attendant, Tournament help, or assistance with fundraising activities.

### Eligibility Guidelines:

- Provide a basis of financial need due to low/no income, excessive medical expenses, family hardships, etc.
- Provide a recent paycheck stub AND a copy of the most recent Federal Income Tax Form (1040) or documentation showing receipt of assistance such as food stamps, Medicaid, SSI, Foster Care, WIC, etc.
- Be willing to contribute at least 50% of registration costs. Only partial hardships/scholarships are available.
- Applications will be kept confidential. Notification of acceptance will be emailed to you.
- Complete this form and put it and supporting documents in a sealed envelope. Place the envelope in the Director of Soccer Operations' (Denise Stauffer) mailbox inside the clubhouse on or before July 1, 2018.
